Tournament Rules:

- 1. Entry fee is Non-Refundable
- 2. Mandatory Boat Check and Check In at Roland Martin Marine Center starting at 5:00am
- 3. Limit 5 Fish 12" Minimum. Short fish will result in disqualification.
- 4. No culling fish live or dead at Ramp or Weigh In.
- 5. 8 oz. penalty per dead fish weighed in. Please make every effort to keep fish alive!!!
- 6. US Coast Guard Approved Floatation Devise MUST BE WORN AT ALL TIMES WHILE COMBUSTION ENGINE IS RUNNING FROM LAUNCH TO WEIGH IN. NO EXCEPTIONS!
- 7. Kill switch must be attached to vessel operator while combustion engine is running.
- 8. Safe boating and Sportsmanship must be observed at all times.
- 9. Consumption or Possession of drugs or alcoholic beverages from check in through your weigh in is prohibited and will result in disqualification.
- 10. Contestants must be inside Clewiston Lock by the pre-determined flight time. NO EXCEPTIONS. Any contestant not completely inside the locks at 3:00pm will be penalized 1 pound per minute late up to 15 minutes. After 15 minutes you will be disqualified. 1 Pound per minute also includes any weight that may be counted towards Big Bass
- 11. All live fish must be released immediately outside the locks.
- 12. No cell phones or radios may be used except in case of emergency or break down.
- 13. Artificial baits only may be used with the exception of pork trailers and Biodegradable soft baits.
- 14. In case of a tie, the two tied places prize will be combined and winnings split equally.
- 15. Exemptions will be handed out at check in.
- 16. Polygraph test can be given at Tournament Directors discretion and/or randomly.
- 17. Protests must be submitted to Tournament Director in writing within 15 minutes of scales closing.
- 18. Anyone under the age of 18 must have signature of parent or guardian on registration and if operating a vessel must have a Boaters Safety Card.
- 19. ALL Decisions by Tournament Director are final.
- 20. THIS IS A TEAM TOURNAMENT, no fishing alone. To qualify for championship, boater must fish 3 of 4 qualifiers and may use only (1) alternate in place of co-angler.
